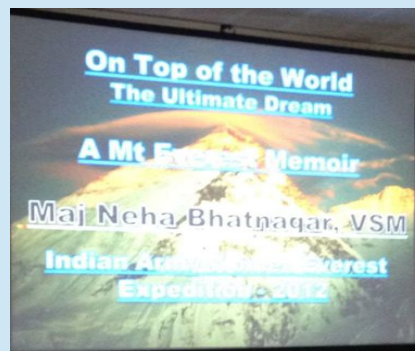
Vimukti Teachers attend skill development session at
